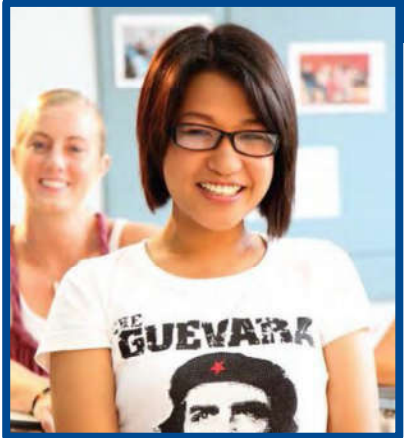

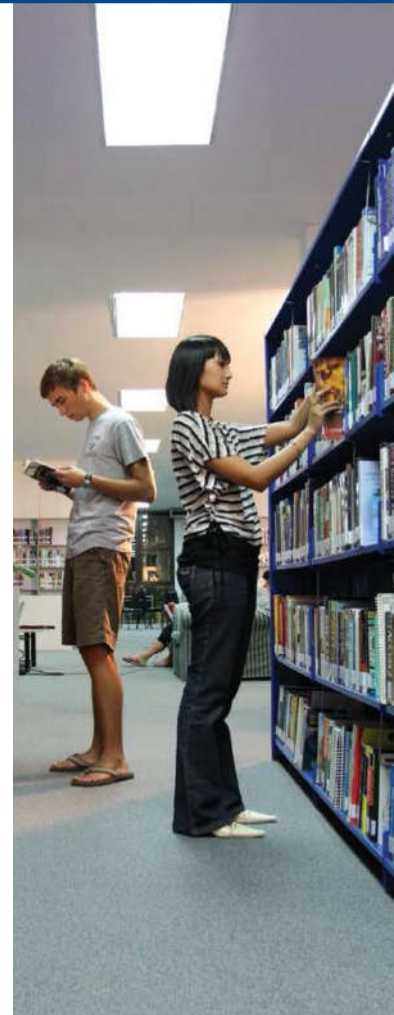

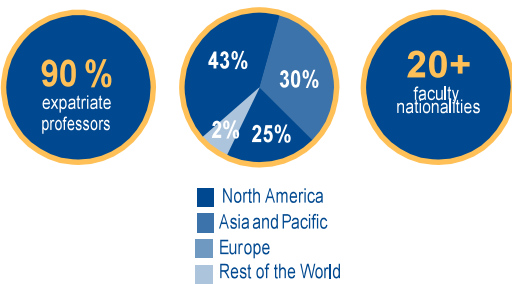

You will also be helped to find internships at leading companies to gain valuable practical experience and perform well in your internships. Many of these companies offer full time jobs to Webster interns after they graduate.

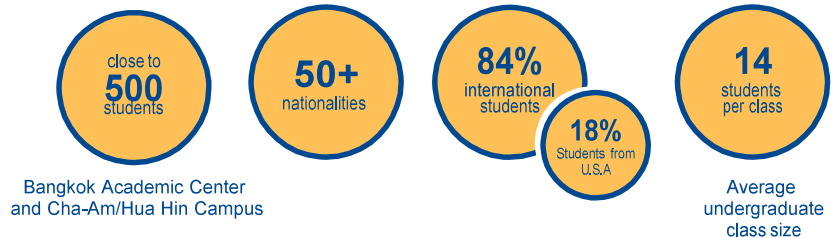

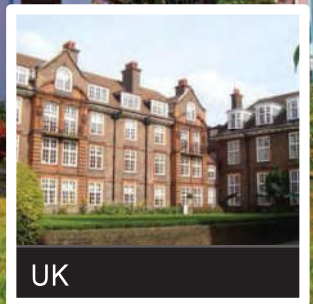
